








His famous books are 'Learning how to fly ', 'Turning points'. He loved to interact with children he relevantly did that throughout his life.

India is our country which has many states and union territories. The capital of our Country, India is New Delhi. Each state has its own capital.









Amongst these planets is our precious mother Earth and it is the only planet known to humans that has the capacity yield life.




On this mother Earth there are seven continents and five oceans.


So it is our duty as Indians to respect India's Independence, value the sacrifices of all the freedom fighters and take India to new heights of success and glory.

Muharram- It is marked the remembrance of Hazrat Imam Hussain.








